**MARCH 2019**

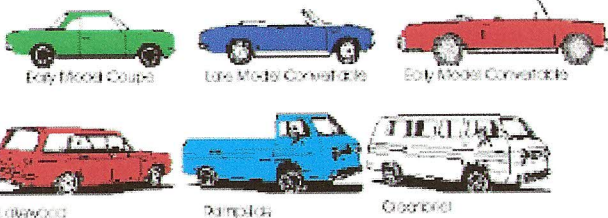

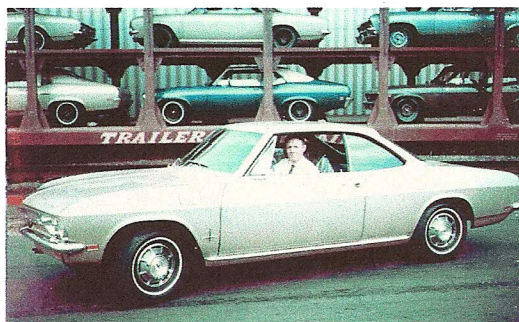

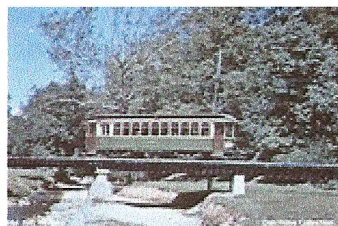
**CLUB APPAREL**

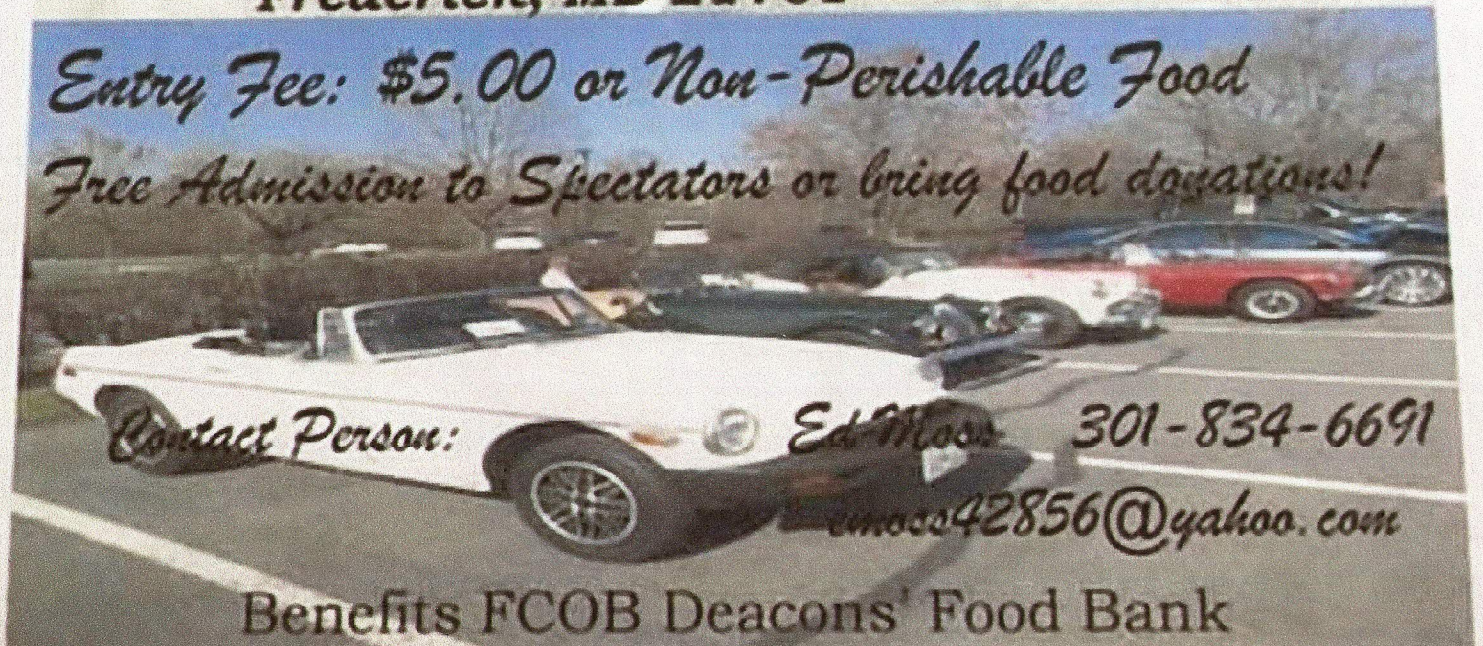

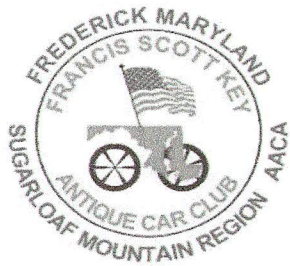

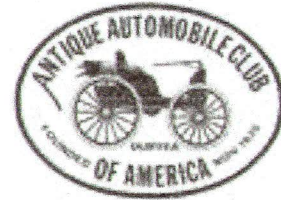
